What is VPP?

VPP is a cooperative relationship between management, labor, and OSHA established at workplaces that have implemented a comprehensive safety and health management system.




Approval into VPP is OSHA's official recognition of the outstanding efforts of employers and employees who have achieved exemplary occupational safety and health.

What are the Benefits of VPP?

- ✓ Improved employee motivation to work safely
- ✓ Recognition in the community
- ✓ Improvement of programs that are already good, through the VPP application process and internal and external review
- ✓ VPP participant sites generally experience from 60 to 80 percent fewer lost workday injuries
- ✓ Removal of site from inspection lists
- ✓ Special Government Employee (SGE) program

Union Buy-In - Unionized sites must have:

- all unions sign application or
- submit signed statement supporting VPP participation.





OSHA History/Good Faith - If OSHA inspects an applicant site 3 years prior to the application, the inspection, abatement and any other history of interaction with OSHA must indicate good faith by the employer.





OSHA History – the following will preclude the site's participation:

- Open enforcement investigations
- Pending/open contested citations or notice of appeal at time of application
- Affirmed willful or 11(c) violations 3 years prior to application
- Unresolved/outstanding enforcement action

TCIR/DART Rates – must be below BLS average

VPP Requirements - Management Leadership & Employee Involvement

- Contractor Safety
- At least 3 means of employee involvement
- Incentive Programs



VPP Requirements – Worksite Analysis

- Are routine safety and health inspections conducted monthly, with the entire site covered at least quarterly (for construction: entire site weekly)?
- Are near-misses investigated?
- Annual evaluation of safety and health program?



VPP Requirements - Hazard Prevention and Control

- Disciplinary system
- Annual emergency drills



VPP Requirements - Safety & Health Training










Growth of VPPFederal & State



Size Of VPP Sites


Number of Sites by Employment (Federal Only)



VPP Sites By Region Federal Only






Distribution Of VPP Sites By State






Top 15 Industries In The VPP
