WISH @ Mid-America Transplant

On Tuesday, April 16, WISH visited Mid-America Transplant for a Lunch & Learn, hosted by Scott Gardner, WISH ally. This was timely as April is Donate Life Month!

Mid-America Transplant has their own lab, hospital/ICU department, organ acquisition process, and morgue. With this come unique safety and health concerns for their staff of over 180, including laboratory staff, warehouse and logistics staff, surgeons, administrative staff, and many others. Challenges include strains due to repetitive motion and lifting, bloodborne pathogen exposure concerns, and cuts (scalpels).

What was most impactful, though, was their story. Making the choice to donate your organs can potentially save 8 other people. How powerful and how amazing to be part of such an impactful organization. We encourage you to explore organ donation and consider signing up to be an organ donor if you aren't already.

Workzone Awareness Week

National Work Zone Awareness Week (NWZAW) is an annual spring campaign held at the start of construction season to encourage safe driving through highway work zones. In 2022, **891 people died in work zones**, according to the NHTSA FARS data. Also in 2022, **94 highway worker occupational fatalities** occurred in road construction sites, based on BLS data.

The 2024 NWZAW will be hosted by Maryland Department of Transportation; this year's theme is "**Work Zones are temporary. Actions behind the wheel can last forever.**" For more information, check out the [NWZAW website](#).
