August Chapter Meeting Meeting

On Monday, September 9, we heard from Domini Montgomery, MPH, ASP, CSP on Deescalating charged conversations. As safety professionals, we oftentimes find ourselves in situations where we need to have difficult conversations, deescalate a situation, or help someone who may be facing a crisis. The safety field is evolving, and our tools need to evolve to keep up with the needs of the folks we serve! We discussed the impact of words, the importance of focusing on all aspects of communication—tone, volume, rhythm of speech, and how to rationally detach. Building from the Crisis Prevention Institute's philosophy, we know that responding appropriately with the right tools can reduce the risk of a negative outcome.

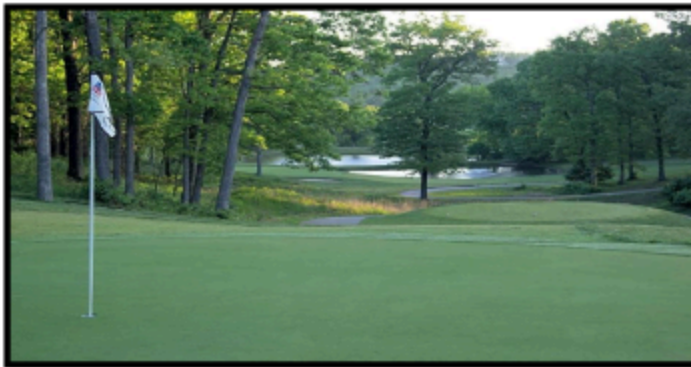
