Chris also attended Saint Louis University's Law School in pursuit of earning a Juris Doctor degree. Selected from top leaders in the St. Louis Metropolitan area, Chris completed the prestigious Leadership St. Louis program. he is a Chris is a Certified Safety Executive (CSE) through the Certification and Accreditation Board of the World Safety Organization. Chris has taught Master and bachelor's degree Safety Management and Engineering courses as an adjunct professor for the University of Central Missouri.

In addition to Chris' successful career in the Environmental, Health, and Safety field, he is currently on the Wyman Center's Board of Trustees. In the recent past, the St. Louis County Executive appointed Chris to St. Louis County Boards and Commissions such as Vice Chairperson of the Economic Council, Chairperson of the Land Clearance for Redevelopment Authority, Chairperson of the Board of Zoning Adjustments, and Wellston Incubator Development Board member. While playing football for ISU, he received top honors as a First Team Kodak All-American, American Football Coaches First-Team AllAmerican, and Associated Press Honorable Mention All-American.

Noteworthy Facts:

In June of 2022 it came to mind as a realization that I am the first African American (Black) Indiana State University football player who eared the All-American First Team (Kodak and Coaches) honor and the second First Team All-American football player i ISU's history between the years of 1865 to 1975.

In addition to college athletic honors, Chris is an inductee in the Withrow High School's Athletic Hall of Fame where he attended and played high school football in his hometown of Cincinnati, Ohio.

Chris Hicks continues to lead the way for success in his endeavors both, professionally and personally by "Paying It Forward" by making a positive difference in his professional field and the community in which he resides.
